

SEX, CONDOMS, AND VIDEOTAPE



Sex, Condoms, and Videotape is a 27-minute, humorous and engaging video of adolescent couples encountering and overcoming typical obstacles to safer sex. During the video, the characters model a diversity of critical safer sex behavior in which they buy condoms in a public place, keep condoms accessible, negotiate sex before and during a sexual encounter, handle safer sex after drinking, substitute safer sexual alternatives for intercourse, exit unsafe situations, and make sure they consistently practice safer sex. The video has been found to provide individuals with safer sex scripts and the self-efficacy to practice HIV-preventive behaviors successfully. U.S. \$100 each.
